DINOSAUR

Materials Needed:
Worsted Weight yarn
G hook (4.25mm)
Poly-fil
Two ¾" buttons for eyes

Abbreviations:
MR: Magic Ring
Sc: single crochet
Inc: increase
Dec: decrease

Notes:

Work in continuous round unless otherwise noted. When you are attaching the head, be sure to stuff the neck firmly. And most importantly, have fun with color combinations!

Head:

R1: In MR, 6 sc (6)

R2: (inc) around (12)

R3: (sc, inc) around (18)

R4 (sc 2, inc) around (24)

R5: (sc 3, inc) around (30)

R6: (sc 4, inc) around (36)

R7: (sc 5, inc) around (42)

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R8: (sc 6, inc) around (48)

R9-18: sc around (48)

R19: (sc 6, dec) around (42)

R20: (sc 5, dec) around (36)

R21-22: sc around (36)

R23: (sc 4, dec) around (30)

R24: (sc 3, dec) around (24)

R25: sc around (24)

R26: (sc 2, dec) around (18) Stuff the head firmly

R27: (sc, dec) around (12)

R28: (dec) around (6)

Finish off. Leave a long to sew the head closed.

Body:

R1: In MR, 6 sc (6) R2: (inc) around (12) R3: (sc, inc) around (18)



R4 (sc 2, inc) around (24)

R5: (sc 3, inc) around (30)

R6: (sc 4, inc) around (36)

R7: (sc 5, inc) around (42)

R8: (sc 6, inc) around (48)

18. (3c 0, 111c) around (4c

R9-17: sc around (48)

R 18: (sc 6, dec) around (42)

R19-20: sc around (42)

R21: (sc 5, dec) around (36)

R22-23: sc around (36)

R24: (sc 4, dec) around (30)

R25: sc around (30)

R26: (sc 3, dec) around (24)

R27: No longer working in rounds – sc 12, ch 1, turn (12)

R28: dec, sc 8, dec . Ch 1, turn (10)

R 29: sc across. Ch 1, turn (10)

R30: dec, sc 6, dec. Ch 1, turn (8)

R31: dec, sc 4, dec . Ch 1, turn (6)

R32: dec, sc 2, dec . Ch 1, turn (4)

R33-34: sc across. Ch 1, turn

R35: Work sc into each stitch of previous row, continue to work along the side of the neck, in the sc remaining from row 27, and along the other side of the neck. Finish off with slip stitch to first sc of this round. Leave a long tail to sew head to body.

Legs – Make 2

R1: In MR, 6 sc (6)

R2: (inc) around (12)

R3: (sc, inc) around (18)

R4-5: sc around (18)

Finish off. Stuff. Leave a long tail to sew to body.

Arms - Make 2

R1: In MR, 6 sc (6)

R2: (inc) around (12)

R3-5: sc around (12) DO NOT STUFF!

R6: Flatten arm, sc through both thicknesses (6)

Finish off. Leave a long tail to sew to body.

Tail:

R1: In MR, sc 6 (6)

R2-5: sc around (6)

R6: (sc, inc) around (9)

R7-8: sc around (9)

R9: (sc 2, inc) around (12)

R10-11: sc around (12)

R12: (sc, inc) around (18)





R13-14: sc around (18)

Finish off. Stuff. Leave a long tail for sewing to the body.

Scales:

Small - Make 2

R1: In MR, sc 5 (5)

R2: (inc) around (10)

R3: sc around (10)

Finish off. Leave a long tail. Flatten scale and sew opening closed.

Medium - Make 3

R1: In MR, sc 6 (6)

R2: (inc) around (12)

R3-4: sc around (12)

Finish off. Leave a long tail. Flatten scale and sew opening closed.

Large - Make 1

R1: In MR, sc 7 (7)

R2: (inc) around (14)

R3-5: sc around (14)

Finish off. Leave a long tail. Flatten scale and sew opening closed.

To Make-up:

- 1. Sew head to body, with head pointing down at a slight angle. See photos for reference.
- 2. Sew tail to body, being sure to finish stuffing before fully attaching.
- 3. Attach legs to the body, being sure to finish stuffing before fully attaching.
- 4. Attach arms.
- 5. Sew on scales starting at base of tail near where it meets the body (look at photos), attach in following order:
 - a. Small
 - b. Medium
 - c. Large
 - d. Medium
 - e. Medium
 - f. Small
